The book is the author’s first and serves as a chronicle of his travels, while introducing the masses to the website, community and outreach program that is Project 1:1000 - an encouraging refuge for artists, writers, students, readers, and travelers; a tool for educators; a platform for community groups and social justice causes; and an outreach program for all of the above. 
